Dear Residents:

The 1930's Water Line Phase II project is between crews at the moment, after successful work was completed along Ashley Rd. Installation on South and Harrison Streets will resume no later than the 1st week of December. There will be through road closures on South and Harrison Streets on a block-by-block basis as needed. The contractor will make every effort to maintain single lane, local traffic for residents on the effected block during construction.

Work continues in the greenspace on the north side of Taylor St across from the village admin building. Concrete pads have been installed for picnic tables provided via a grant from the Delaware Public Health District. We will continue to develop the park space as time, funds and resources allow.
