OHIO ELECTIONS 2022

May 3, 2022

Primary election, often abbreviated to primaries, are a process by which voters can indicate their preference for their party's candidate, or a candidate in general, in an upcoming general election, local election, or by-election.

The **Police Levy** will be on the ballot on May 3rd in a Primary Election.

August 2, 2022


Special election means an election which is held to fill a vacancy in a Federal office. A special election may be a primary, general, or runoff election. If there are no vacancies to put on ballot and a municipality would like to put something on the ballot, then the municipality would have to pay for the special election.

November 8, 2022

A **general election** is an election in which candidates are elected to offices. This is in contrast to a primary election, which is used either to narrow the field of candidates for a given elective office or to determine the nominees for political parties in advance of a general election.

"The pole was made from three sections of pipe telescoped and welded together".
