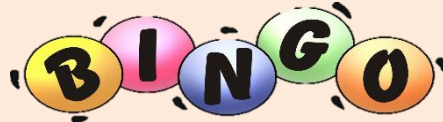

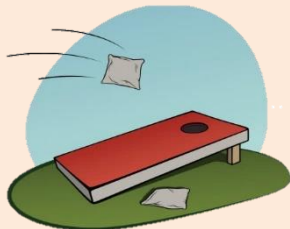

TIPS FOR ANIMALS**

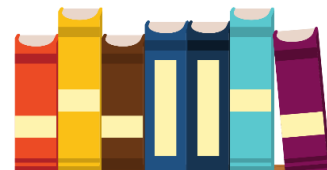
- **NEVER** leave an animal inside a hot vehicle - they could die
