What's on the ballot? STREET LEVY

The village receives: \$112,999.00
From Property Tax, Sales Tax,
Gasoline Tax, State and County License Tax.

This pays for: The salary for maintenance worker, to mow village properties, plow snow in the winter, fuel for vehicles & vehicle maintenance, street lights in town, supplies & materials, natural gas, phones, and auditing services, etc.

\$100,000 has been set aside from the general fund to pay for street paving.

This is a renewal levy and will **NOT** cost anymore than what you are currently paying.
